HISTORY OF KANNADA RAJYOTSAVA:

The history of Kannada Rajyotsava dates back to 1956 when the state was reorganised on a linguistic basis. The region had been under the rule of various dynasties and empires, including the Chalukyas, Hoysalas, Vijayanagara and the British. On 1 November 1956, the Kannada-speaking regions of the erstwhile Bombay Presidency, Hyderabad State and the Madras Presidency were merged to form the state of Mysore, which was later renamed Karnataka in 1973. This day was declared a state holiday and is now celebrated as Kannada Rajyotsava.

SCOPE OF THE PROGRAM

Celebrated on 1 November each year, Kannada Rajyotsava marks the day the state of Karnataka was formed. This day is a testament to the rich cultural heritage and the spirit of unity that defines this vibrant state.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE EVENT
