MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called as the 'MoU') is entered into on this 19th December 2023, by and between



Industry-Institute Interaction Cell (IIC), Kammavari Sangham Institute of Technology (KSIT), having its office at #14, Raghuvanahalli, Kanakapura Road, Bengaluru 560109 hereafter referred as "FIRST PARTY", represented by Dr. Dilip Kumar K, Principal as the party of the Academic Institution through Prof. Rajesh G.L, Chief coordinator for Industry Institute Interaction Cell, KSIT.

And



Government Tool Room & Training Centre (GTTC) - an organization having its office situated at Rajajinagar-Bangalore, herein referred as "SECOND PARTY" represented by Mr. Nagendra J, Head - CoE and Mr. Ashok Walikar, Nodal officer – CoE, GTTC.

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH
IN THIS MOU,
THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1) CO-OPERATION:

Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share the information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

2) SCOPE OF THE MOU:

The potential graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.

The K.S Institute of Technology is very well equipped with the faculty as well as laboratory resources with best infrastructure to fulfill its objectives. GTTC is well equipped with team of professionals experienced in the field of precision engineering work, mechatronics and electronics along with the state of art sophisticated manufacturing facility. In order to utilize the resources of both parties effectively for the benefit of perusing undergraduate, graduates and faculties both the parties agree to work on potential initiatives.

These initiatives include:

- **Industrial Training/Internship and Project work:**
 1. Industry and Institution interaction will give an insight in to the latest developments/requirements of the industries; Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready at a cost as mutually agreed upon.
 2. The industrial training and exposure provided to students through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. Second party to help the students of first party in academic project work in terms of technical support.
- **Skill Development Programs:**

Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready
- **Invited Expert Lectures:**
 1. Bringing in speakers with proven expertise from industry in a specific topic provides added credibility to the contents of the curriculum.



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2. This provides students not only with different points-of-view, but also with potential resources they can apply in later courses.
 3. In this connection, second Party to extend the necessary support to organize/deliver guest lectures/Invited talks/workshop to the students as well as faculties of the First Party on the technology trends and in emerging fields.
- **Industry visits:**
Second party shall permit students and faculties for an industry visit atleast once/twice/thrice a year depending on the availability.

Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programmes on the terms specified herein.

There is no financial commitment on the part of the Kammavari Sangham Institute of Technology, the First Party to take up any Programme mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

3) INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

4) CLAUSE OF VALIDITY

- This MoU will be taken effect from the date it is signed by the representatives of both parties. It will be valid for a period of *three years* from the date of signing. The agreement is renewable further as per the need of both parties after suitable review.
- Both parties shall take all responsible steps to ensure the successful completion of the collaboration and shall cooperate with each other in performance of their respective obligations. Either party may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the other party, one month in advance.
- However, both parties will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to complete successfully.

5) ARBITRATION CLAUSES:

- All disputes, differences or claims arising out of or in relation with this MOU not limited but inclusive of as regards to rights, liabilities, damages, claims, breach or interpretation of this MOU between the Parties shall be referred to arbitration.

- Any party shall give a written notice to other party of existing such dispute, difference or claim. On receipt of such notice within 10 days, the Head of Institution of KSIT and the Partner, GTTC or any other persons so nominated by the respective parties, shall meet together and try to resolve such dispute, difference or claim amicably. If such amicable solution is not arrived within one month, then the matter shall be referred to Arbitration.

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
