The awareness program was carried out in two sessions.

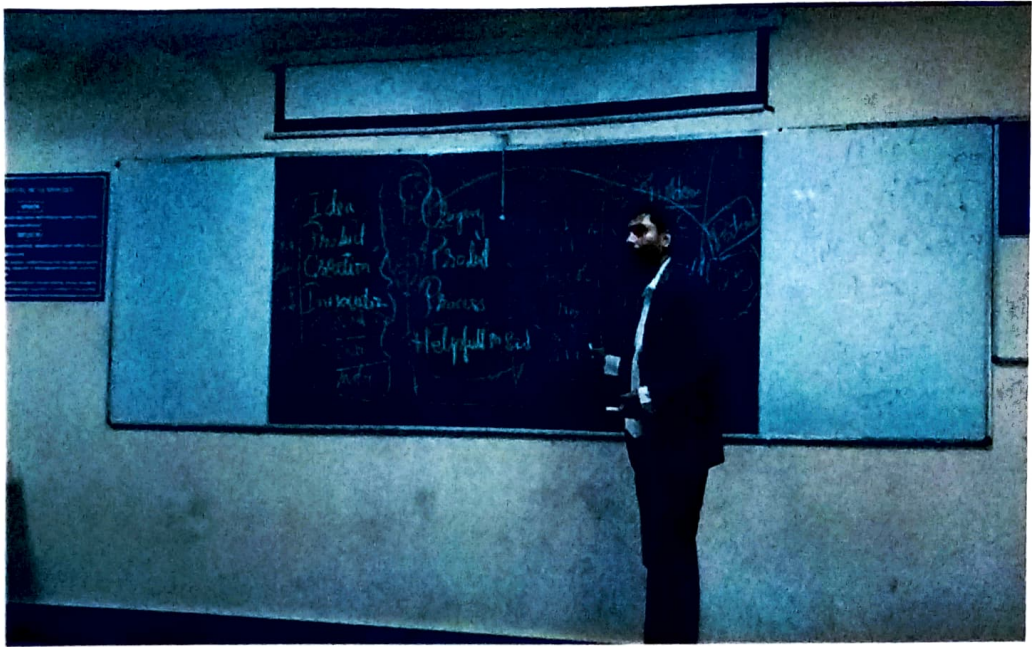
- IP and academics



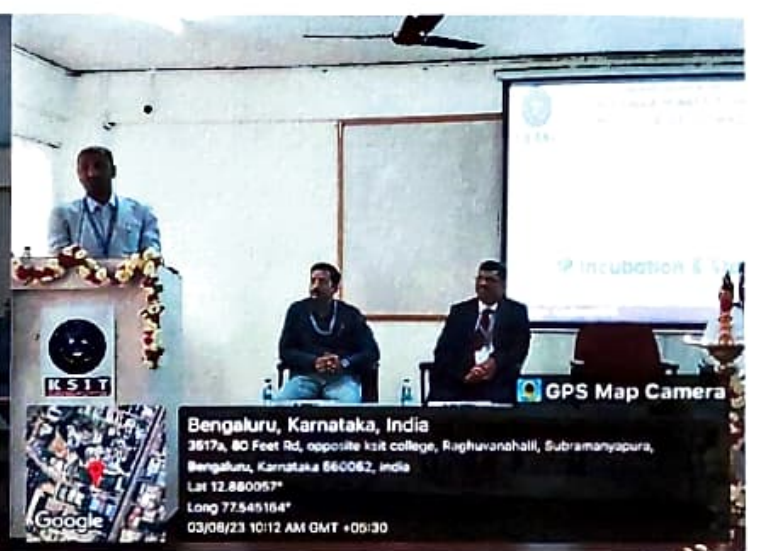
