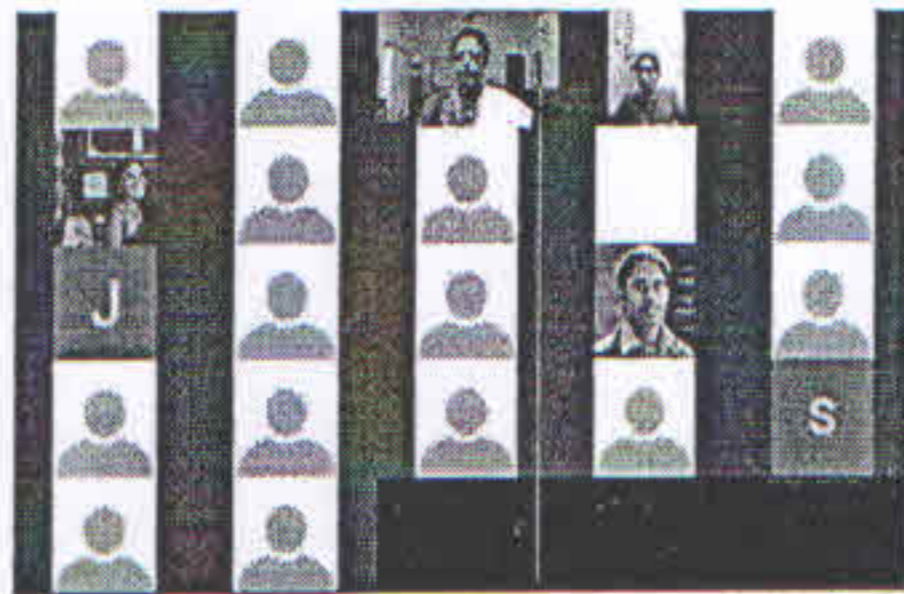

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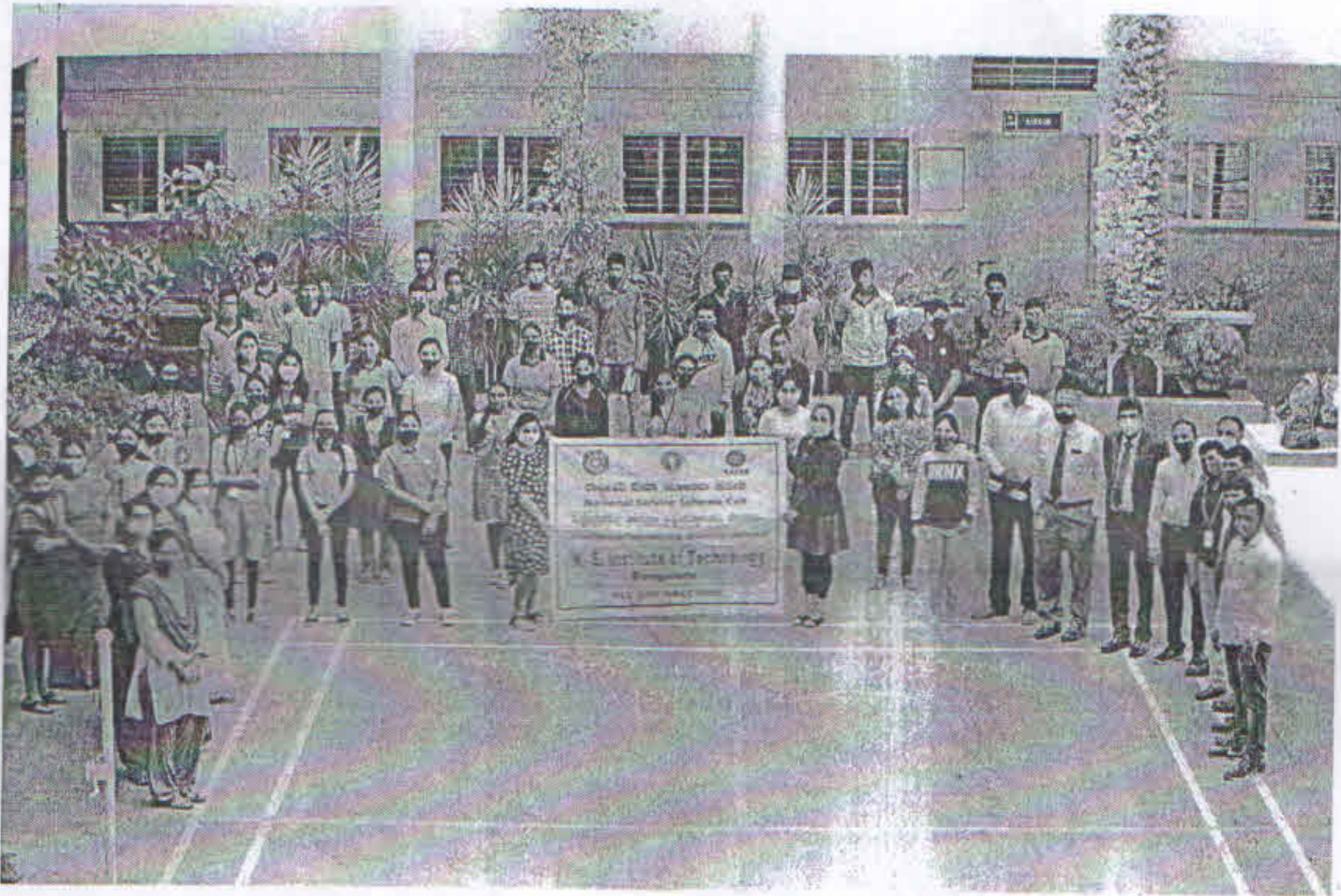


Then all the student volunteers joined hands together and cleansed the college surrounding by picking up all the plastic materials.

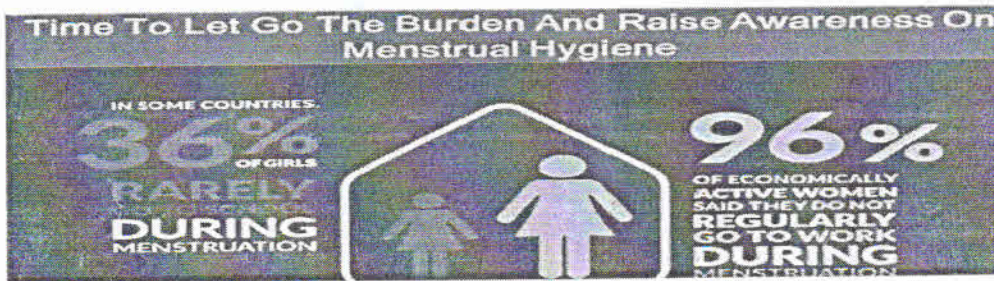

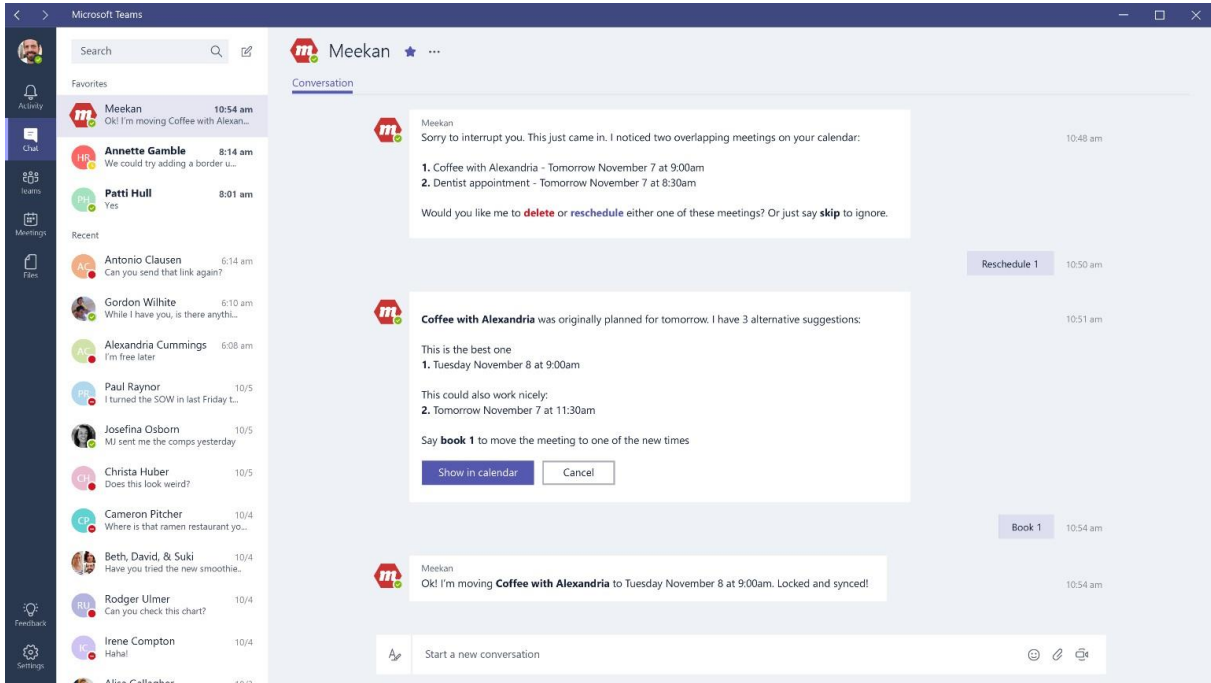
2. Lack of technical /Software knowledge

Learners also can respond immediately to the teacher if there are any doubts about formula and equations. Therefore, the researcher asked the respondents how difficult it is to teach numerical subjects through online mode.





EXPERIENCE DURING ONLINE ASSESSMENT AND ASSIGNMENT

Interferences and Creative suggestions in improving performance through online mode

- **Interferences**

- 1. Cheating is easier to do (and harder to detect) online.**

While it's not clear whether online students do, in fact, cheat more than face-to-face students, the truth is that it is more difficult to monitor who's taking a test and how they're taking it online than it is in a classroom.

2. Performance assessments (such as presentations and demonstrations) can be more challenging to administer online.

Putting students "on the spot" in a classroom setting (by assigning them to demonstrate a process or deliver a speech to the entire class, for example) can strengthen their communication skills and help them learn from each other. Online, however, students need to be able to package their presentations so that their instructors and fellow students can view and provide feedback on them.

3. Online courses need more student-to-student interactions "built in" than do face-to-face courses.

In a classroom setting, students interact socially (chatting before class starts) and as part of common classroom activities (asking questions for clarification, weighing in on impromptu discussions, etc.) Online, these opportunities to feel connected and learn from each other do not occur naturally; they must be carefully planned and managed.

- **Creative suggestions**

1. Build a personal connection with your students.

Instead of simply introducing yourself, consider conducting a student survey. Then share the results with your students, while inserting your own responses to the questions.

2. Motivate your students.

Motivation is a key to effective learning, and perhaps the single most important contributor to motivation is the course's perceived relevance. Thus, it is important to discuss the course's utility, value, and applicability from the outset. Help your students understand the ways that your course provides an essential foundation for more advanced courses, how it will help them acquire particular skills.

The fort is located in Sakaleshpura taluk, 4 kilometres (2.5 mi) away from the Sakaleshpura town to its south west, which is on the right bank of the Hemavati River, 23 miles (37 km) from Hassan on the National Highway 75 that runs from Bangalore to Mangalore.

An iconic landmark and one of the most sought places to see in Karnataka is Manjarabad Fort. A star-shaped massive fort constructed by Tipu Sultan in 1792 is located at a height of 988 mts, approximately 3241 feet above sea level. It has been observed, on a clear sky day, people can also see the Arabian sea from the fort.

The heritage city of Karnataka, Hassan has a lot more to offer to tourists of all segments. Sakleshpur Taluk in the district is a hill station with lush greenery and beautiful landscapes. A visit to the star-shaped, Manjarabad fort is a must to do in your checklist. Built-in European style, Tipu Sultan got this fort built one day by his soldiers when he was establishing his sovereignty over Mysore. Manjarabad fort got its name from the Kannada word 'Manju' which means fog or mist. So when Tipu Sultan visited the fort after its completion there was a mist all over and above the fort, hence the name.

Although the fort is constructed in a European style, the raw materials used to build the fort included granite stones and lime mortar for the exterior walls, and the interiors are constructed with fired bricks. The fort was used to store army barracks, and armoury, and to store gunpowder.

The lush greenery, muddy trails uneven hillocks, valleys, streams, and dense forests are the views you can expect while standing on the fort wall. The unbelievable formation of nature leaves nature-lovers and history enthusiasts spellbound.

History

Tipu Sultan built the fort in 1792 at a time when he was establishing his sovereignty over Mysore, fighting against other South Indian dynasties. At this time even the Marathas and the Nizam of Hyderabad had aligned with the British. The Sultan wanted to make the highway between Mangalore and Coorg secure for his expansion programmes. Because he was allied with the French at that time against the British, he sought the help of French engineers to build a star fort of the European style.

The completed fort was inspected by Tipu Sultan who then found it enveloped in fog and hence named it as Manjarabad fort; the name Manjara is a version of 'manju' meaning "fog or mist" in Kannada.

Features

The fort, as built and existing, is an eight-pointed star. The external walls of the fort have been built with granite stones and lime mortar while the interior buildings, which accommodate army barracks, armoury, stores and others, have been built with fired bricks. Apart from these, two cellars were built next to a deep well which were underground structures used to store gunpowder, and these rooms remained cool even during summer months. The fort has sloping walls. It is said that the fort is "the most complete Vaubanesque star-shaped fort in India".

1. Annotate on screen share

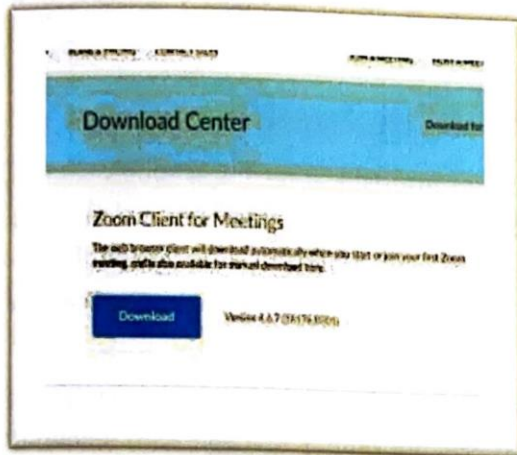

Alternatively, you can also install Teams using the Windows Package Manager (winget) in Command Prompt. Here's how:

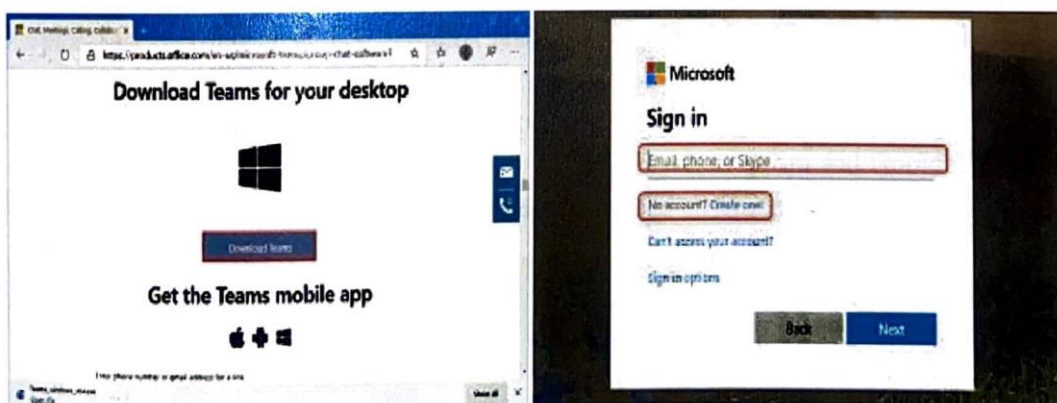
Open Start.

Type the following command to install Microsoft Teams on Windows 10 with winget and press Enter:

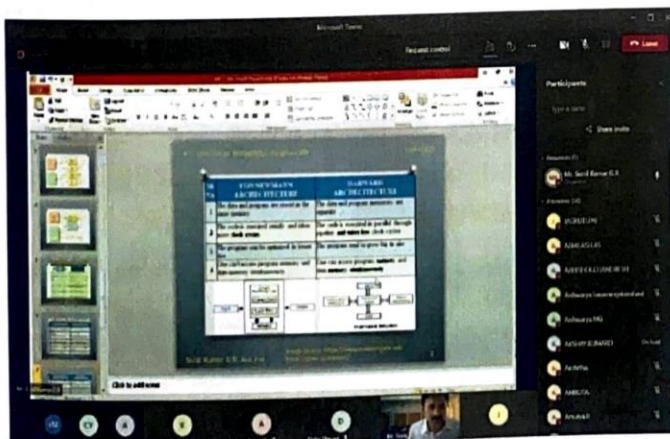
