

Meditation can put you in a state where it can help you take better decisions. She gave insights on how meditation can help deal with the current pandemic. She spoke about healthy food habits and immune boosting foods. Overall it was a very interactive session. It is important to create the awareness and preparedness of the targeted community members, especially youngsters.






## Report on Government Schools Visited







#### Go Green zero Waste Period

Talk on "Go Green zero Waste Period" by Dr. Hamsaveni Srinivasan, Motherhood Children and women Hospital, was conducted for II<sup>nd</sup> and III<sup>rd</sup> year students of all branches under Anti Sexual Harassment (ASH) committee, KSIT as per VTU notification dated 21/7/2017 with Ref:VTU/BGM/ICC/2017-18/3118on 11<sup>th</sup> September 2020. This was aevent of one hour(2pm am to 1 pm)webinar was organized KSITin association withMotherhood Children and women Hospital and IEEE.



Dr. Hamsaveni, works as a Consultant Obstetrician and Gynaecologist, and also works as educator and content developer. She conducted number of workshops for children, teachers and parents. Dr. Hamsaveni became social worker from high school and joined Lions club international 10 year ago and currently serving as President for My Club BTM Nightingle, Bangalore.

Dr. Hamsavenipresented brief introduction on Women's hygiene and health issues during menstrual cycle. Speaker mentioned, now days women are getting the opportunities to talk freely about the problem that can face during menstrual cycle. Prime minister of India Mr. NarendraModi discussed certain related issue on menstrual cycle during independence speech 2020. Menstrual Hygiene Day is an annual awareness day on May 28 to highlight the importance of good menstrual hygiene management. It was initiated by the German-based NGO WASH United in 2014. In low-income countries, the choices of menstrual hygiene materials are often limited by the costs, availability and social norms.





In webinar Doctor provided brief introduction on menstruation cycle, various risk factors of using sanitary pads and challenges in disposing of used sanitary pads.

Doctor also mentioned that usage of Disposal Tampons are not good and causes many health issues.

#### Eco hazards

- Single use product made up of plastic, chemicals
- No option of reuse/recycle/reduce
- Swells in water—chokes drains
- Foul smell
- Attract flies, insects and animals
- Dogs get them from garbage and spread all over roads
- Sanitary workers exposed to diseases as they separate it manually
- Sewage system clogging
- Contamination of underground water

Doctor provided information on various reusable/sustainable hygiene products such that



and usable of these products, advantages and disadvantages of these products.










In webinar speaker provided brief introduction on Stress Management, various risk factors of that increases stress and challenges in handing the stress to manage the health and studies.


#### 2. Lack of technical /Software knowledge

Interferences and Creative suggestions in improving performance through online mode

#### Interferences

#### 1. Cheating is easier to do (and harder to detect) online.

While it's not clear whether online students do, in fact, cheat more than face-to- face students, the truth is that it is more difficult to monitor who's taking a test and howthey're taking it online than it is in a classroom.

## 2. Performance assessments (such as presentations and demonstrations) can be more challenging to administer online.

Putting students "on the spot" in a classroom setting (by assigning them to demonstrate a process or deliver a speech to the entire class, for example) can strengthentheir communication skills and help them learn from each other. Online, however, students need to be able to package their presentations so that their instructors and fellow students can view and provide feedback on them.

## 3. Online courses need more student-to-student interactions "built in" than doface-to-face courses.

In a classroom setting, students interact-socially (chatting before class starts) and as part of common classroom activities (asking questions for clarification, weighing in on impromptu discussions, etc.) Online, these opportunities to feel connected and learnfrom each other do not occur naturally; they must be carefully planned and managed.

#### • Creative suggestions

#### 1. Build a personal connection with your students.

Instead of simply introducing yourself, consider conducting a student survey. Then share the results with your students, while inserting your own responses to the questions.

#### 2. Motivate your students.

Motivation is a key to effective learning, and perhaps the single most important contributor to motivation is the course's perceived relevance. Thus, it is important to discuss the course's utility, value, and applicability from the outset. Help your studentsunderstand the ways that your course provides an essential foundation for moreadvanced courses, how it will help them acquire particular skills.

## Manjarabad Fort -

Manjarabad fort is a star fort built in 1792 by Tipu Sultan the then Sarvadhakari/ruling on behalf of Mysore King of Mysore following French star-shaped fort designs made popular by Sébastien Le Prestre de Vauban that deflect cannon fire and allow guns to cover all approaches without dead positions. It is in the Hassan district in the Indian state of Karnataka.

The fort is located in Sakaleshpura taluk, 4 kilometres (2.5 mi) away from the Sakaleshpura town to its south west, which is on the right bank of the Hemavati River, 23 miles (37 km) from Hassan on the National Highway 75 that runs from Bangalore to Mangalore.

## **ABOUT THE PLACE**

An iconic landmark and one of the most sought places to see in Karnataka is Manjarabad Fort. A star-shaped massive fort constructed by Tipu Sultan in 1792 is located at a height of 988 mts, approximately 3241 feet above sea level. It has been observed, on a clear sky day, people can also see the Arabian sea from the fort.

The heritage city of Karnataka, Hassan has a lot more to offer to tourists of all segments. Sakleshpur Taluk in the district is a hill station with lush greenery and beautiful landscapes. A visit to the starshaped, Manjarabad fort is a must to do in your checklist. Built-in European style, Tipu Sultan got this fort built one day by his soldiers when he was establishing his sovereignty over Mysore. Manjarabad fort got its name from the Kannada word 'Manju' which means fog or mist. So when Tipu Sultan visited the fort after its completion there was a mist all over and above the fort, hence the name.

Although the fort is constructed in a European style, the raw materials used to build the fort included granite stones and lime mortar for the exterior walls, and the interiors are constructed with fired bricks. The fort was used to store army barracks, and armoury, and to store gunpowder.

The lush greenery, muddy trails uneven hillocks, valleys, streams, and dense forests are the views you can expect while standing on the fort wall. The unbelievable formation of nature leaves nature-lovers and history enthusiasts spellbound.

## History


Tipu Sultan built the fort in 1792 at a time when he was establishing his sovereignty over Mysore, fighting against other South Indian dynasties. At this time even the Marathas and the Nizam of Hyderabad had aligned with the British. The Sultan wanted to make the highway between Mangalore and Coorg secure for his expansion programmes. Because he was allied with the French at that time against the British, he sought the help of French engineers to build a star fort of the European style.

The completed fort was inspected by Tipu Sultan who then found it enveloped in fog and hence named it as Manjarabad fort; the name Manjara is a version of 'manju' meaning "fog or mist" in Kannada.

#### **Features**

The fort, as built and existing, is an eight-pointed star. The external walls of the fort have been built with granite stones and lime mortar while the interior buildings, which accommodate army barracks, armoury, stores and others, have been built with fired bricks. Apart from these, two cellars were built next to a deep well which were underground structures used to store gunpowder, and these rooms remained cool even during summer months. The fort has sloping walls. It is said that the fort is "the most complete Vaubanesque star-shaped fort in India".




