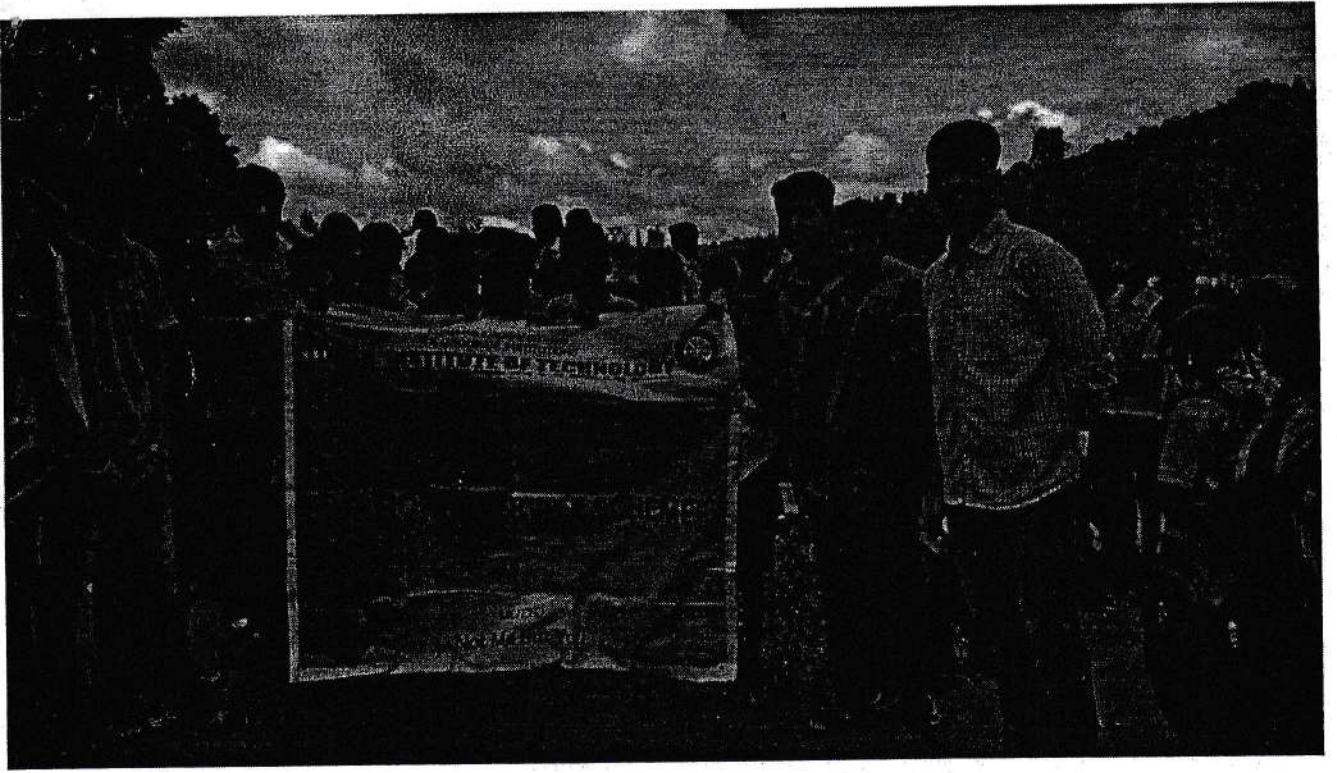

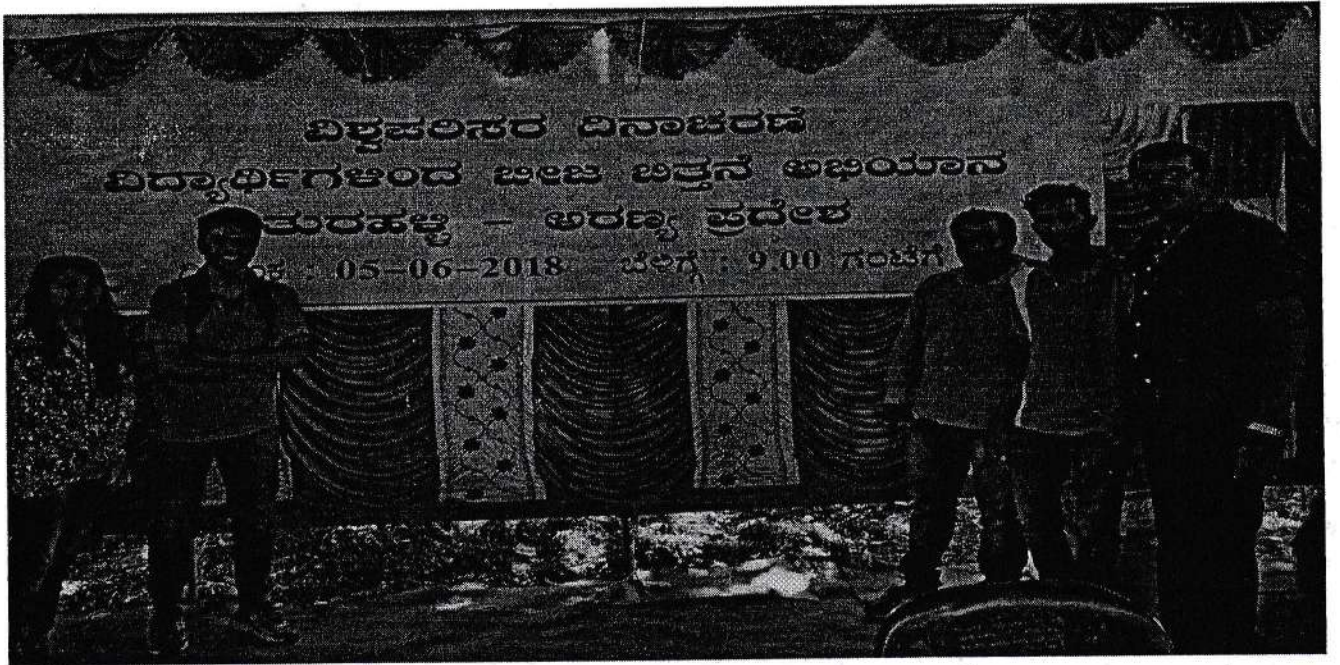

AASARE started with purchasing of fruits for the old age home. The elders shared their past experiences & guided students to lead a successful life. It was a great experience for all the members.






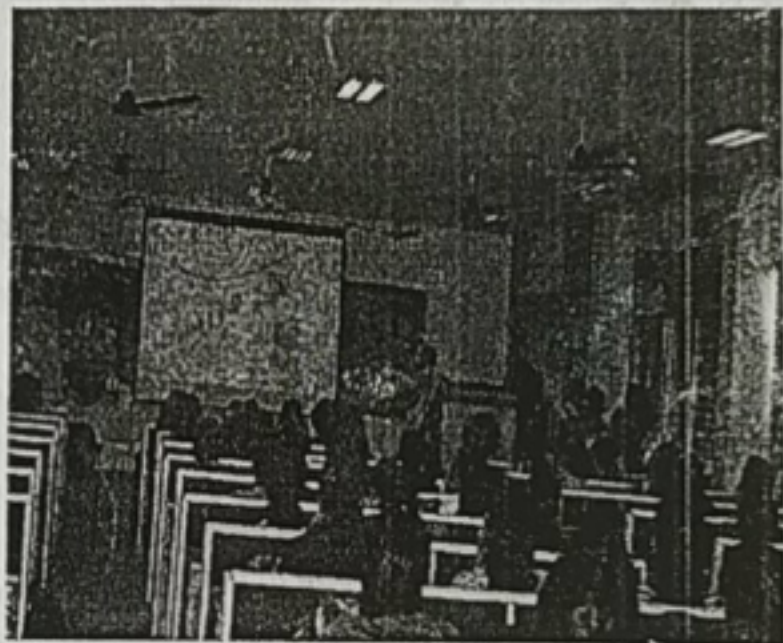

The event consisted of a talk on "Nurture the Future-Empower the Adolescent Girls" by Dr. Hemavathi Srinivasan, MBBS, DNB(OBG) FFMM at 1.30pm to 2.15pm in Electronics and Communication Engineering seminar hall followed by "Women's Safety" tactics demonstration in quadrangle by Dr. Ritesh Reddy, Director, Institute of Combat Studies and team, at 2.30 pm. Pranayam can greatly help in getting the hormones back to normal.



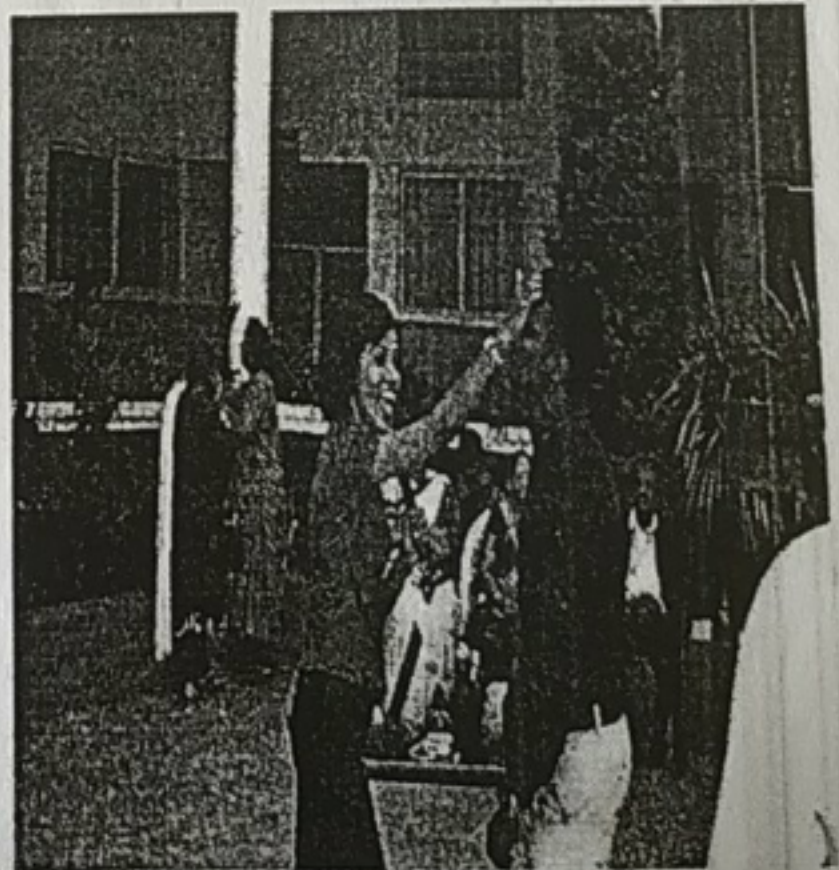
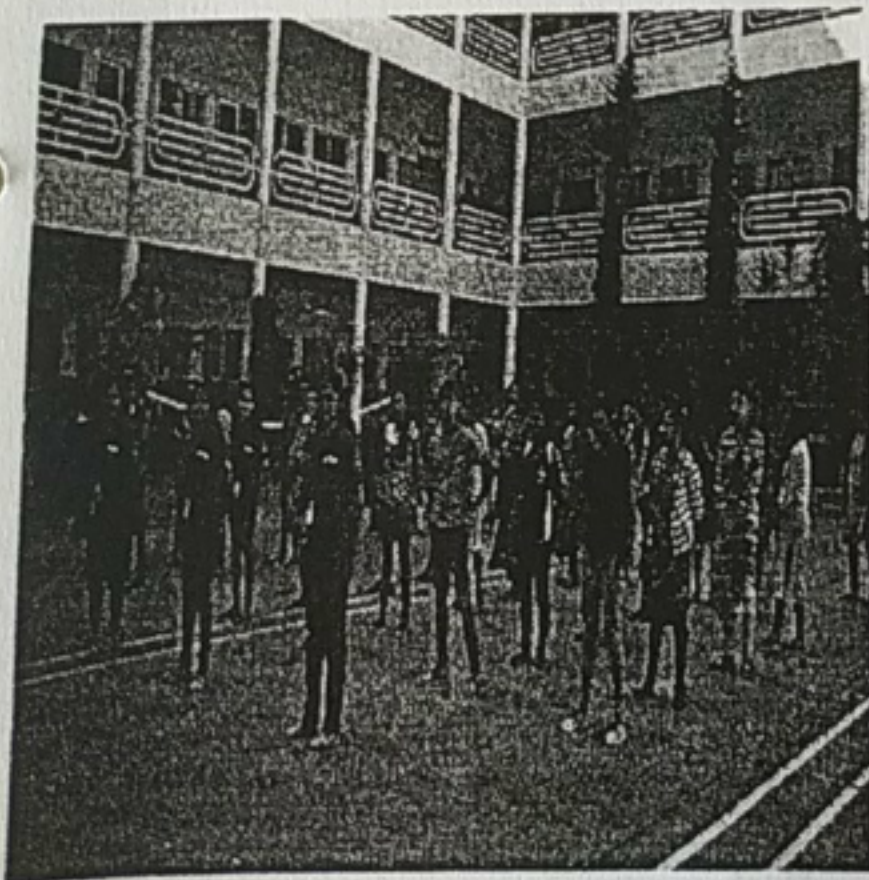
Diet

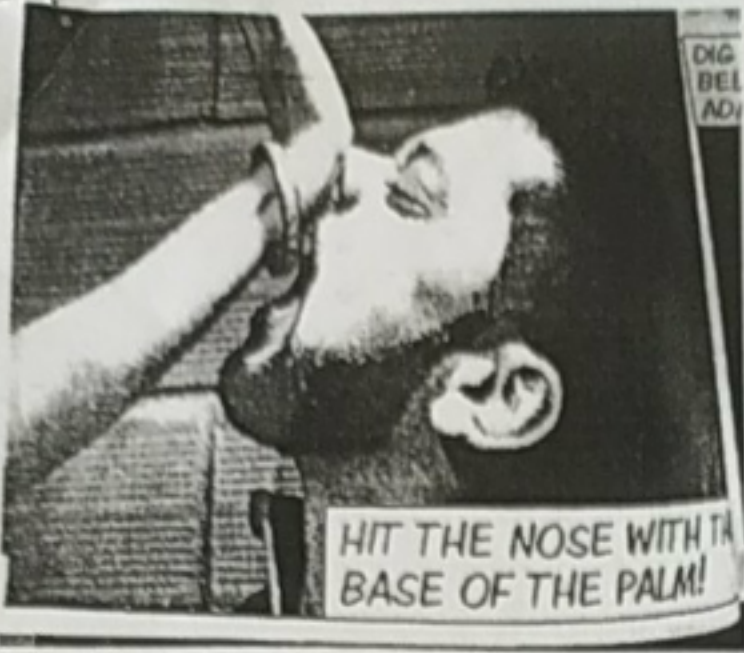
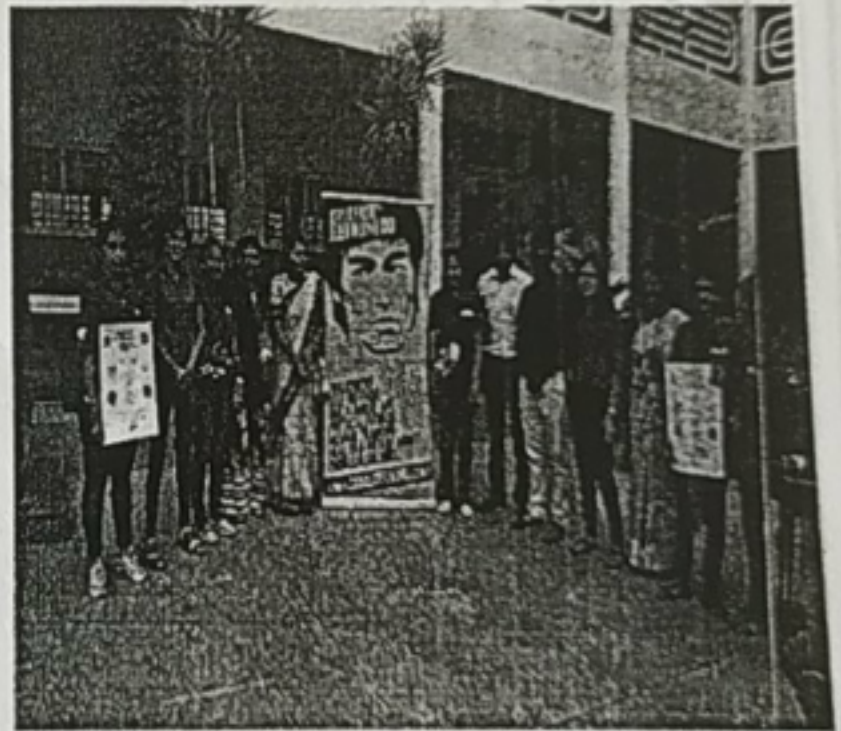


Fig1. Picture from "Women's Safety" book

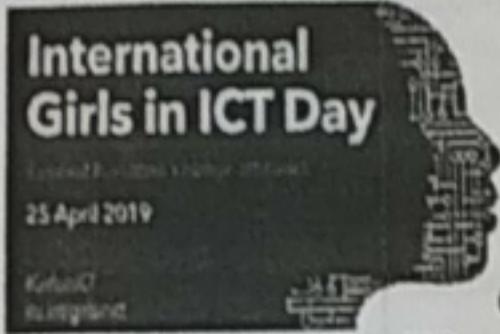

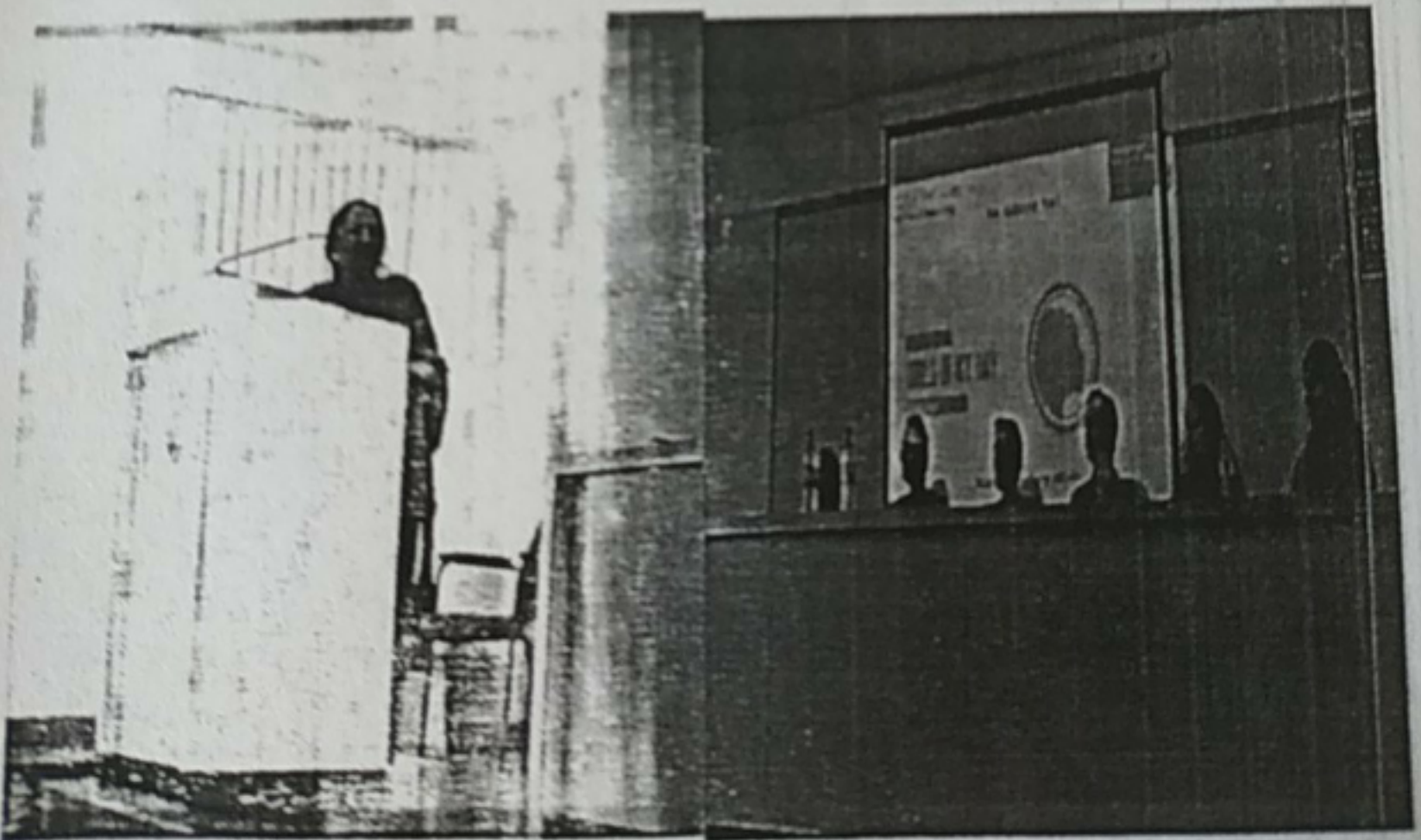

The event was started with the introduction of team members by Dr. Kamal Deep Peter. The first talk on cloud computing was given by Hemant Bansal.

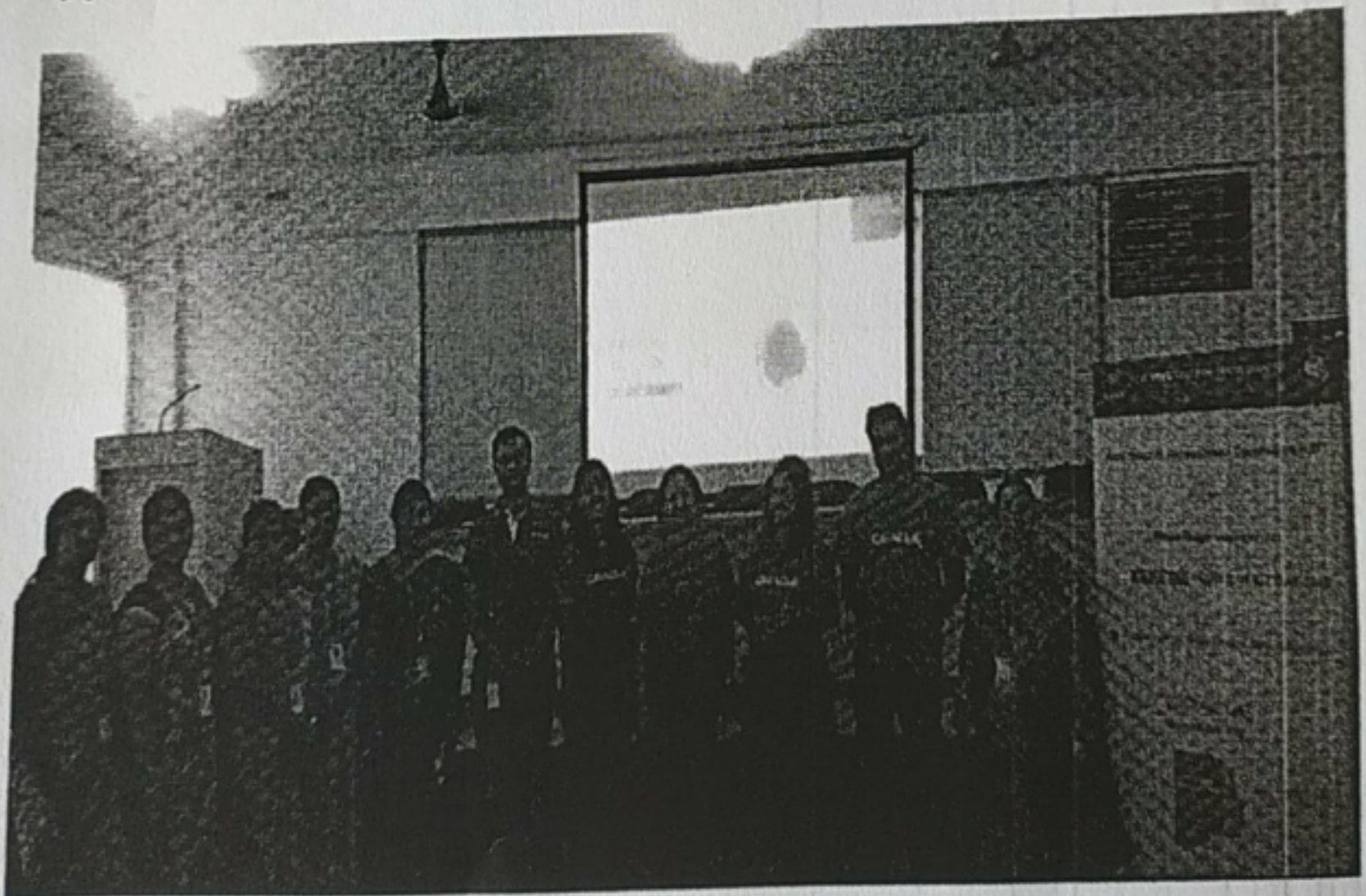
Topics name: Cloud - Models, Technologies and Learning Resources

The session informed students on how to kick –start their cloud careers with knowledge, relevant training and certifications in the field and boost their employability chances.

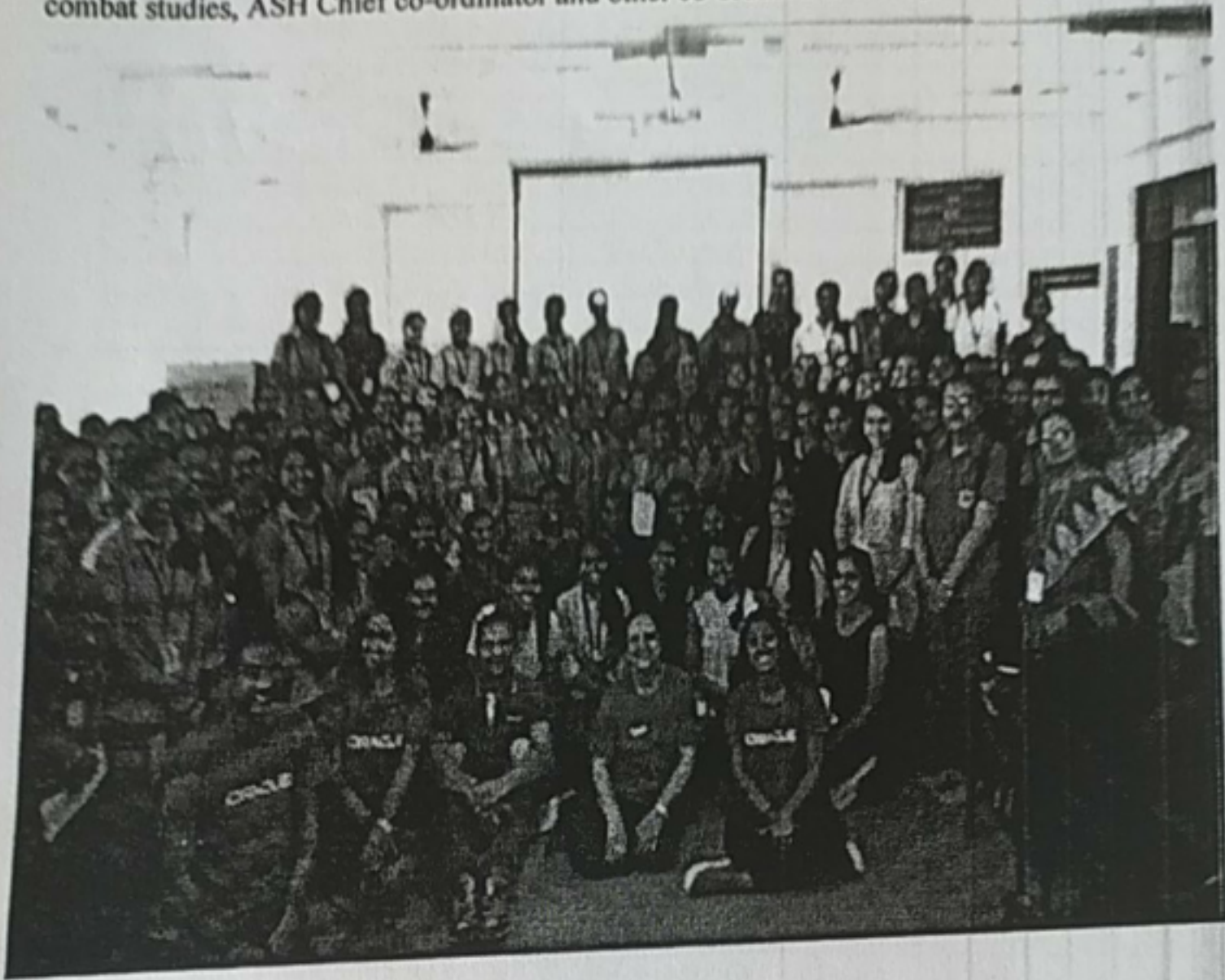

- Debate on topics

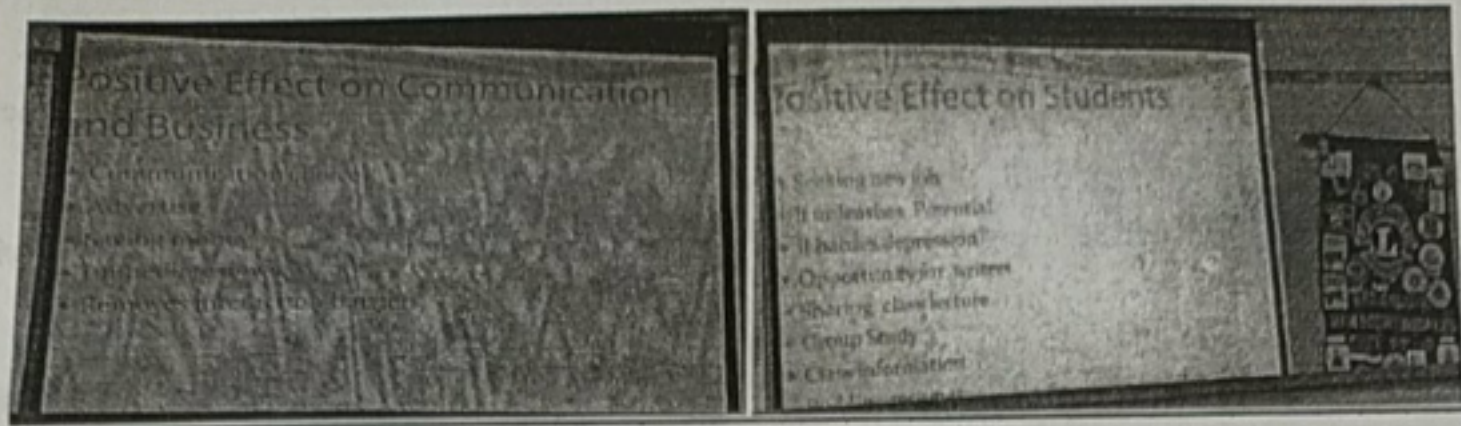

Communication choice – to communicate with friends, family members, business partners, teachers etc social media is first choice now days.

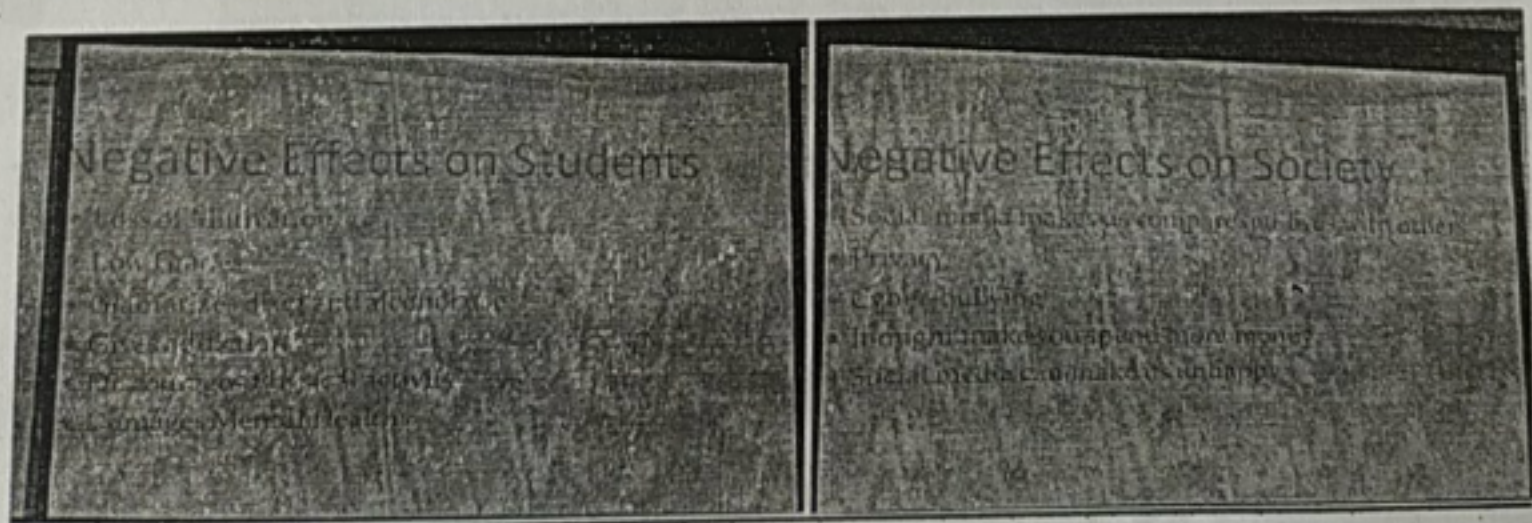
Advertisement of new product can be done on facebook, whatsapp, flicker etc

Compared positive effects negative effects of social media is increasing very where on human beings. Some examples are

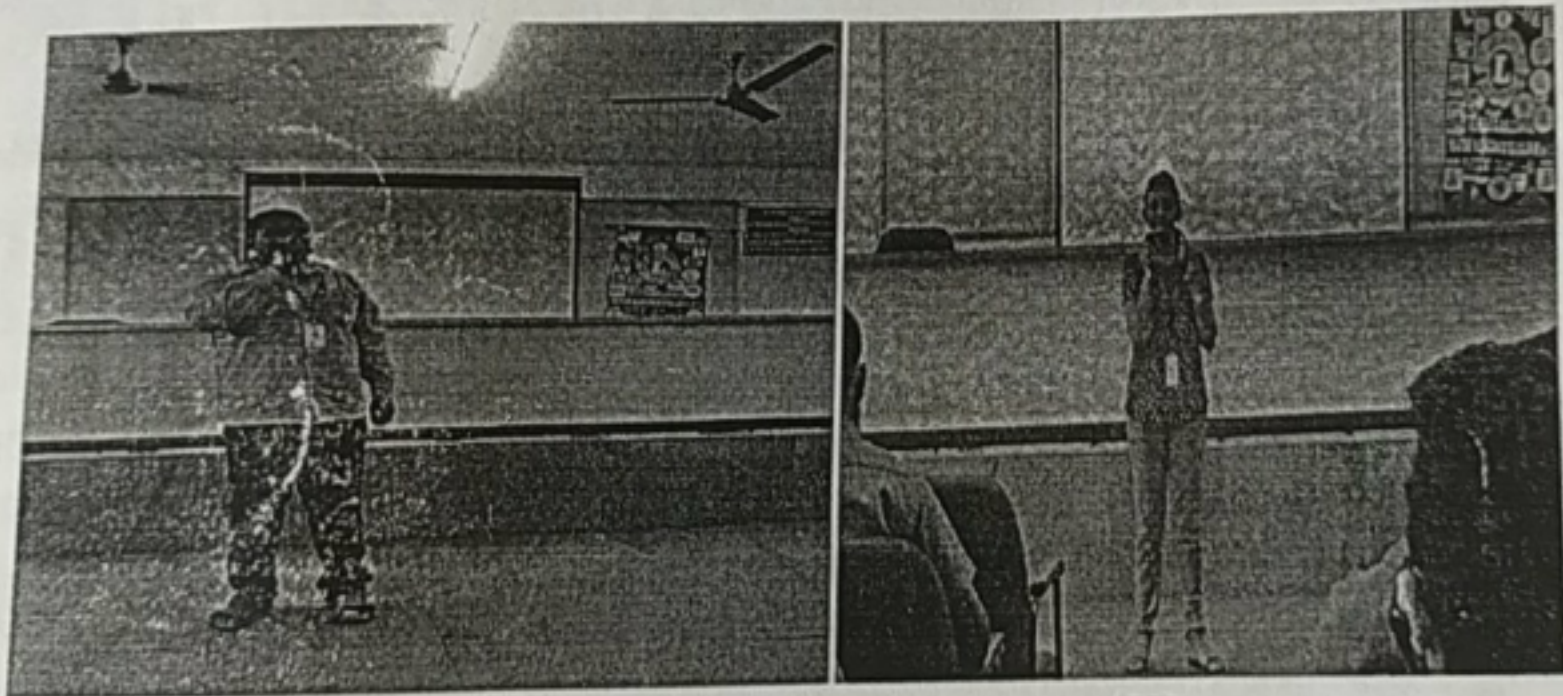
With use of facebook, instagram and whatsapp people always compare their life with others and become unhappy.

INTRODUCTION

Wall paintings can be called Murals. They can be created by working directly onto a wall. A characteristic of murals is the way they incorporate architectural elements seamlessly into the artwork. Murals dating right from the Upper Palaeolithic Age to the Egyptian era have been discovered. The word 'mural' became more popularly used after the Mexican 'Muralist' Art Movement.

From all the various styles and methods of creating wall paintings – 'Murals'; the best-known technique is the fresco, which combines a lime wash and natural water-soluble colours. Ajanta – Ellora caves, caves from the Kaymer range, some parts of Uttar Pradesh and the rock shelters of Bhimbetka in Madhya Pradesh are the earliest evidences of wall paintings in India.

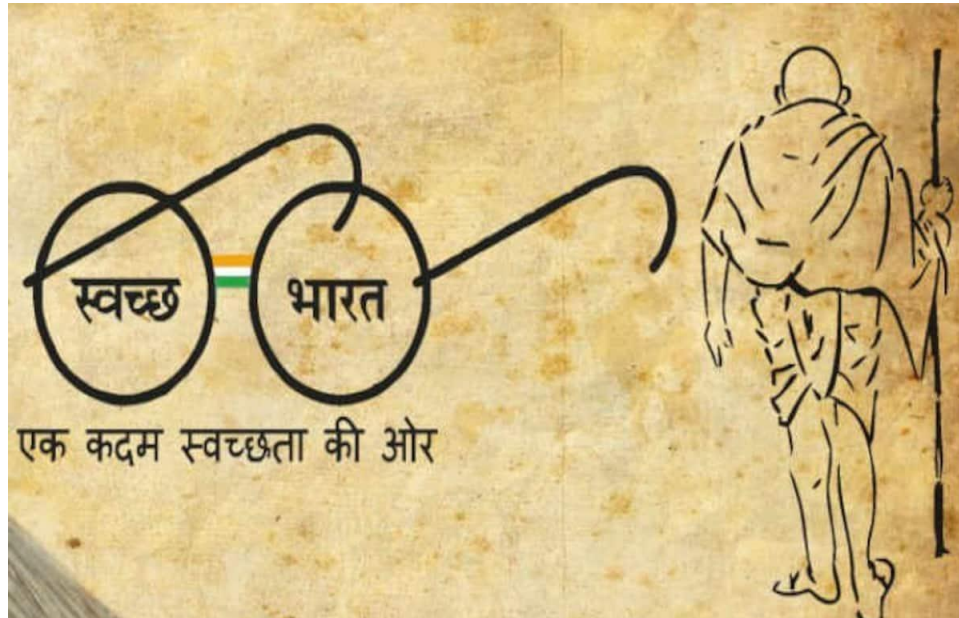
In today's context, wall paintings serve different purposes. Not only do they bring art into a public space, the artists also receive more recognition. One can find artworks around different parts of the city. They are also used effectively for social causes and political messages. Graffiti – a type of wall painting has often been created against the law, however, now due to their particular style and popularity they are commissioned by pubs, bars and restaurants.

In India they were created by people on the walls inside and outside their homes, identifying their tribes, religious beliefs and so on. Today people can be found commissioning such murals to express their personal choices and individuality. This feature has increased commissioned work amongst artists across the world. Incorporating certain messages and elements according to the theme, hand painted murals serve different purposes for hospitals, corporate offices and schools.

Many people like to express their individuality by commissioning an artist to paint a mural in their home. This is not an activity exclusively for owners of large houses. A mural artist is only limited by the fee and therefore the time spent on the painting; dictating the level of detail; a simple mural can be added to the smallest of walls.

Chapter 2

IDEA FOR WALL PAINTING



Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM), Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, or Clean India Mission is a country-wide campaign initiated by the Government of India in 2014 to eliminate open defecation and improve solid waste management. It is a restructured version of the Nirmal Bharat Abhiyan launched in 2009 that failed to achieve its intended targets.

Phase 1 of the Swachh Bharat Mission lasted till October 2019.

Phase 2 is being implemented between 2020–21 and 2024–25 to help cement the work of Phase 1. Initiated by the Government of India, the mission aimed to achieve an "open-defecation free" (ODF) India by 2 October 2019, the 150th anniversary of the birth of Mahatma Gandhi through construction of toilets. An estimated 89.9 million toilets were built in the period.^[6] The objectives of the first phase of the mission also included eradication of manual scavenging, generating awareness and bringing about a behaviour change regarding sanitation practices, and augmentation of capacity at the local level.

The struggle for India's Independence began in 1857 with the Sepoy Mutiny in Meerut. Later, in the 20th century, the Indian National Congress and other political organizations, under the leadership of Mahatma Gandhi, launched a countrywide independence movement. Colonial powers were transferred to India on August 15, 1947.

The Constituent Assembly, to whom power was to be transferred, met to celebrate India's independence at 11pm on August 14, 1947. India gained its liberty and became a free country at midnight between August 14 and August 15, 1947. It was then that the free India's first prime minister Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru gave his famous "Tryst with Destiny" speech. People across India are reminded of the meaning of this event - that it marked the start of a new era of deliverance from the British colonialism that took place in India for more than 200 years.

The period leading up to Independence Day is a time when major government buildings are illuminated with strings of lights and the tricolor flutters from homes and other buildings.
