K.S INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY, THE SECOND PARTY, and represented herein by its Prof Dr. Harish, (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party", institute which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party') as

WHEREAS:

- A) First Party is a Training Organization: **The SKILL FACTORY** is engaged in Skill Development of the student Community.

CLAUSE 1

CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY

4.1 This Agreement will be valid from June 01,2020 until July 01,2022, it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period THE SKILL FACTORY, the First Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of Training Partner or THE SKILL FACTORY, the First Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU.

4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 15 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations. SKILL



CLAUSE 5 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

5.1 It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MOU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act,1996. The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of Bangalore.
